Bridgestone and Bridgestone West - Collection Schedules

Garbage Collection – 2xWeek – Hand pick up at the Curb – Monday and Thursday

Recycling Collection – 95 Gallon Cart – 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each Month – Only those items in the recycling cart will be collected.

Heavy Trash Collection – 1xWeek – Hand pick up at the Curb – Thursday

Note: Please have your garbage/recycling at the curb by 7 a.m.

Holiday Schedule - Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day. If your service day falls on a Holiday, service is provided on the next service collection day.

Service Hours - No earlier than 7:00 a.m. and no later than 7:00 p.m.

In the event of an "Act of God" Republic Services will collect on the next regular collection day once service has resumed.

Garbage Collection – 2xWeek – 95 Gallon Cart – Monday and Thursday – Only items place in the garbage cart will be collected.

Recycling Collection – 95 Gallon Cart – 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each Month – Only items placed in the recycling cart will be collected.

Heavy Trash Collection – 2xMonth – 1st and 3rd Thursday of each Month

Note: Please have your garbage/recycling at the curb by 7 a.m.

Holiday Schedule - Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day. If your service day falls on a Holiday, service is provided on the next service collection day.

Service Hours - No earlier than 7:00 a.m. and no later than 7:00 p.m.

In the event of an "Act of God" Republic Services will collect on the next regular collection day once service has resumed.



Garbage Collection Protocol:

The Following Items and Materials Will Not be Accepted

- Dead Animals
- Disaster Storm Debris
- Chemical containers over 5 (five) gallons
- Nuclear/radioactive waste
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Gasoline
- Insecticides/Arsenic
- Pool Chemicals
- Stain
- Solvent
- Power Steering Fluid
- Anti-Freeze/Coolant
- Herbicides
- Pesticides
- Propane Tanks
- Ammunition or Explosives
- Chemicals not in original containers
- Mercury
- Thermometers
- Unidentified Chemicals
- Oil
- Flammable Chemicals
- Paint
- Varnish
- Batteries
- Transmission Fluid
- Used Oil Filters
- Poison
- Medical Waste
- Construction Materials
- Lumber
- Trees
- Carpet



Heavy Trash Protocol:

Acceptable Items

Household Appliances, Hot Water Heaters, Mattresses, Large Volumes of Yard Waste, Furniture, Grills

Appliances with Freon must have Freon drained and be tagged accordingly by a certified technician

Hot water heaters must be drained

Grills must be emptied of ash or briquettes.

No propane tanks.

Unacceptable Items

- Wood
- Nails
- Sheetrock or drywall
- Windows
- Insulation
- Carpet
- Tile
- Paneling
- Doors
- Masonry debris/Stone
- Pool filters
- Lawn mowers
- Concrete
- Dirt in large quantities
- Disaster Storm Debris
- Tree Trunks
- Water Softeners
- Tires
- Steel or cast iron building material



Packing Peanuts:

Packing peanuts may not be offered loose, they must be bagged. Drivers will not clean up packing peanut spills.

Garbage with 95 Gallon Carts:

Please place bagged garbage in your garbage carts. Loose garbage may blow out when being emptied on windy days.

Yard Waste:

Bush and tree trimmings cut in lengths not to exceed 4 feet, no greater than 2 inches in diameter, securely tied in bundles, not to exceed 35 lbs.

All grass clippings, and leaves must be bagged.
