

Post Wood MUD Rate Order

Rates effective October 1, 2023

Rates are subject to change without prior notice

Article III Service Rates

Section 3.01. Water Service Rates

The following monthly rates for the sale of water shall be in effect for each Separate Connection within the District from the effective date hereof until such time as the Board of Directors amends said rates:

Single-family Residential

0-1,000 gallons	\$17.00 (minimum)
1,001 – 8,000 gallons	\$ 1.60 per 1,000 gallons
8,001 – 13,000 gallons	\$2.10 per 1,000 gallons
13,001 – 18,000 gallons	\$2.60 per 1,000 gallons
18,001 – 23,000 gallons	\$3.50 per 1,000 gallons
23,001 and thereafter	\$4.50 per 1,000 gallons

Any Non-standard Residential including Commercial

0 – 5,000 gallons	\$45.00 (minimum)
5,001 – 10,000 gallons	\$ 2.50 per 1,000 gallons
10,001 – 25,000 gallons	\$3.50 per 1,000 gallons
25,001 and thereafter	\$4.00 per 1,000 gallons

In addition to the rates above, the North Harris County Regional Water Authority (NHCRWA) assesses a fee on all water pumped in its jurisdiction for the purpose of converting to surface water. Their fee as of October 1 of 2023 is **\$4.03 per 1,000 gallons.** The NHRWA fee is added to each customer's monthly water bill.

Section 3.02. Sewer Service Rates

The following monthly rates for the collection and disposal of sewage shall be in effect for each Separate Connection within the District from the effective date hereof until such time as the Board of Directors amends said rates:

Single-family Residential \$51.00 per month per connection includes trash or recycling services

Commercial & Non-standard Residential

0 – 5,000 gallons \$50.00 (minimum)

does not include trash or recycling services

5,001 gallons \$ 3.00 per 1,000 gallons

and thereafter

Rates are subject to change without prior notice.

For tracts with both a Commercial connection and a Residential connection, Commercial rates shall apply, and no solid waste collection shall be provided.

Standard Residential Connections must be on platted tracts with service provided by a road bore not to exceed 40 feet.
