Dear Resident of Harris County WCID 92,

We at Best Trash are very excited to be your trash and recycling service provider. Best Trash has a reputation in the industry as a provider with customer service as their prime focus. Your services are billed through your utility district, so there is no need to contact us to set up an account. However, should you ever have an issue with your services, please contact us right away so we can investigate the issue and resolve it for you.

Trash Service Details:

- Trash pick-up on Wednesday and Saturday
- Have trash at curb before 7:00 AM
- Household waste: Two (2) can limit per service day
 - o Residents are to provide their own trash container up to fifty (50) gallons.
 - Each bag/container must be a safe weight (about 40 pounds)
- Yard waste: Limited to combination of eight (8) bags/bundles per service day
 - Limbs must be less than 4 feet in length and bundled
 - Bundles and bags must be a safe weight (about 40 pounds)
- Bulk waste: One (1) bulk item will be picked up each Saturday (restrictions apply)
- All service questions and issues should be reported to Best Trash North via their website at https://rrtx.net/contact_us/

Recycling Service Details:

- Recycle pick-up on Saturday
- Have recycle at curb before 7:00 AM
- Place recycling on opposite sides of driveway from trash on Saturday
- Only use clear bags or recycling containers.
 - o Items in black or white bags will not be picked up
- One 18G Recycling bin will be provided for your use. (pick up at clubhouse 1911 Bellchase Dr)
- Recycling stickers are available for delivery upon request for additional recycling containers

Guidelines for Pickup

- ONLY USE CLEAR BAGS or RECYCLING CONTAINERS. Items in black or white trash bags will not be picked up
- Have items out by 7AM
- Place recycling on opposite side of driveway from trash
- If you move, please leave the recycling container at the home
- ❖ Pickup Day Saturday
 ❖ Place out by 7AM
 ❖ Where to Place for Pickup Curbside
 ❖ Recycling Bin Provided one 18 Gallon Bin (pick up at clubhouse 1911 Bellchase Dr.)

- Paper magazines, newspapers, copy paper, phone books, junk mail, etc.
- Plastic #1 through #7 (NO Styrofoam) juice,
 water, milk, soda, detergent, cleaners, RX bottles. (If in doubt, check bottom of container for recycling emblem and number in center)
- Aluminum any type of soda beer or drink can, etc.
 (PLEASE RINSE OUT)
- Tin Cans any food can, pet food can, etc. (no aerosol containers) (PLEASE RINSE OUT)

- Cardboard boxes, cereal, food, detergent, pet food, etc. (No grease stained boxes or containers with food)
- Glass any color glass. Must be pure glass.
 Cannot be ceramic, mirror, pottery stoneware, or china type items.
- Thin Plastics bags from grocery, sleeve on newspaper, wrapping on dry cleaning – bags MUST be tied together and put into another bag. NO LOOSE BAGS.



Items that CANNOT be recycled in your cart

- Light Bulbs
- Batteries
- Fabric
- Diapers
- Pottery Ceramics
- Air Filters

- Computers
- Paper plates
- Napkins
- Paper towels
- Wood
- Food/Pizza Boxes

- Scrap Metal
- Styrofoam
- Appliances
- Hangers
- Yard Waste
- Hazardous Materials

WCID 92 Trash Guidelines

Quick Pickup Guide

- Pickup Days Wednesday & Saturday
- Have items out by 7AM
- Items must be placed curbside
- Bulk items picked up on Saturday
- 1 bulk item limit per day
- Resident provides own trash can
- Residents must provide their own trash container any size shape or color is acceptable
- Trash service days are Wednesday & Saturday
- Items must be placed curbside by 7:00AM.
- Trash must be properly contained in either bags or cans, each weighing less than 40 lbs.
- Yard waste will be collected curbside. Yard waste has a limit of 8 bags, bundles or a combination per pickup day.
- All trash and yard waste should be placed in sturdy plastic bags weighing no more than 40 pounds each.
- All branches and tree trimmings should be no more than 3 inches in diameter and no longer than four (4) feet in length. Bundles must be securely tied and weigh less than (40) forty pounds each.
- Bulk items/heavy trash will be picked up curbside on Saturday. There is a limit of one item per household per week. Bulk item must be less than 5 feet in length.
- Holidays observed are: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. If the holiday falls on a regularly scheduled service day, there will be no service that day.
 Service will resume on the next <u>scheduled</u> collection day following the holiday.

EXCLUDED ITEMS

- Excluded items: It is illegal to transport any hazardous waste in a trash truck and dispose of it in a landfill.

 Hazardous waste includes: medical waste, toxic or radioactive waste, any appliance containing Freon, acids, car batteries, dead animals, and chemicals of any kind, car parts, car tires, and construction trash (includes concrete, large quantities of carpeting, fencing, rolls of carpet or any construction type material or debris).

 Other excluded items include: Large pieces of glass (must be broken down in smaller pieces and placed in a closed box and labeled), metal items, improperly contained animal waste (animal waste must be placed in a sealed bag to be serviced). CFC (Freon) items are no longer acceptable items at the landfills, so we are no longer able to pick up refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or any other item containing Freon.
- Excluded Liquid Waste Toxic or radioactive waste, Freon, paint, acids, petroleum products or filters are not
 accepted, cooking oil, or chemicals of any kind.
- Bulk items which are too large for Contractor to put in with the normal weekly pickup may be collected separately upon request. Party requesting service will be billed separately at a negotiated price depending on size, quantity and handling required to remove and dispose of item(s).
