Drought and Emergency Condition Water Conservation Measures

Below is a brief summary of the applicable conditions and restrictions of the Drought Contingency Plan (the "Plan") for Wood Trace Municipal Utility District No. 1 (the "District").

STAGE 1 WATER SHORTAGE CONDITIONS

• Restrictions:

- ✓ Customers with an even numbered address voluntarily limit irrigation of landscaped areas to Sundays and Thursdays between 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. the following day.
- ✓ Customers with an odd numbered address voluntarily limit irrigation of landscaped areas to Saturdays and Wednesdays between 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. the following day.
- ✓ Customers responsible for watering common areas such as esplanades or medians voluntarily limit irrigation of those common areas to Tuesdays and Fridays between 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. the following day.
- ✓ Customers are requested to practice water conservation and minimize or discontinue nonessential water uses.

STAGE 2 WATER SHORTAGE CONDITIONS

• Restrictions:

- ✓ The restrictions of Stage 1 apply mandatorily for irrigation of landscaped areas, washing of motor vehicles or aesthetic water use on the designated days and during designated hours.
- ✓ Irrigation is, however, permitted at any time if by means of hose-end sprinklers, hand-held hose equipped with a positive shut-off nozzle, faucet filled bucket, watering can of five (5) gallons or less or drip irrigation.
- ✓ All vehicle washing shall be done with a hand-held bucket or hand-held hose with a positive shutoff nozzle.
- ✓ Aesthetic water use for facilities such as an ornamental fountain or pond is only allowed where necessary to support aquatic life or if equipped with a recirculation system.
- ✓ Use of water from hydrants shall be limited to firefighting, related activities, or other activities necessary to maintain public health, safety, and welfare or under special permit.
- ✓ All other non-essential water uses are prohibited.

STAGE 3 WATER SHORTAGE CONDITIONS

• Restrictions:

- ✓ The restrictions of Stage 2 apply mandatorily.
- ✓ All irrigation and aesthetic water use is prohibited. However, irrigation is permitted at any time if by means of hose-end sprinklers, hand-held hose equipped with a positive shut-off nozzle, faucet filled bucket, watering can of five (5) gallons or less or drip irrigation.
- ✓ Vehicle washing is prohibited on residential premises.
- ✓ The District's Operator is authorized to allocate water to customers in accordance with the Plan.

STAGE 4 WATER SHORTAGE CONDITIONS

• Restrictions:

- ✓ The restrictions of Stage 2 and Stage 3 apply mandatorily.
- ✓ The District's Operator is authorized to allocate water to customers in accordance with the Plan.

Any person violating these restrictions shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$200 and not more than \$1,000 for each offense. If three (3) or more violations occur at the same premises while Stage 2 or Stage 3 is in effect, upon due notice, water service may be discontinued. If one (1) or more violation(s) occur while Stage 4 is in effect, upon due notice, water service may be discontinued.
